Driven Dressage Arena:

Class 1	20 x 60 m indoor, sand
Classes 2 & 3	30 x 60 m indoor, sand
Classes 4 to 7	40 x 80 m outdoor, sand

Obstacle-Cone-Driving with fixed Obstacles: 30 x 70 m indoor, sand or 40 x 80 m outdoor, sand

Obstacle-Cone-Driving Fault Competition: 30 x 70 m indoor, sand or 40 x 80 m outdoor, sand

Practice Arena: 50 x 100 m sand

Invitations: Single Pony: up to 8 Competitors with 1 pony each per Nation,
Nations with 3-8 Competitors in 3-6 Classes form a Team
Pony Pairs: up to 2 Competitors with up to 3 ponies each per Nation

Austria – the Host Nation – is allowed to enter twice the number of Competitors and Teams.

Invitations to compete are sent to National Federations and to representatives of ICKD or organisations who care for kids driving in their countries.

The total number of entries is limited to 120. Therefore the Organising Committee has the right to reduce the number of Competitors after the Nominated Entry Date.

IV Accommodation & Catering:

a) Competitors, Grooms, Chefs d'Equipe, Accompanying Persons.

A campsite of sufficient size to accommodate Competitors and accompanying persons with their vehicles will be supplied. Sufficient sanitary and showering facilities, for male and female persons, with hot and cold water as well as electricity (~230V) will be provided by the OC. No private electric generators are allowed on the campsite.

The costs for using the campsite by up to 3 persons per Competitor is included in the Camping Fee which is charged per Competitor.

The accreditation for the Chef d'Equipe, one Veterinarian and one Trainer per Nation is free of charge. Additional accreditations can be purchased at the Show Office.

Catering facilities will be situated at the event site as well as near to the event site. Shops for self catering are located very close to the event site. Catering is at the participants own expense.

Camping space requirements (number and type of vehicles, number of persons) must be advised, in writing, with the Nominated Entries.

b) Ponies

Sufficient boxes (3 x 3 m) for Ponies will be supplied by the OC. One box will be reserved per Single and two boxes per Pair. The need for additional or less boxes as well as the type of bedding (straw or shavings) must be ordered, in writing, with the Definite Entries at the latest. The fees for these boxes, first bedding included, will be charged to Competitors. The housing of Ponies in Competitors own tents or vehicles is not permitted. The stables will be open from Monday, 21. July 08:00 to Monday 28. July 12:00.

c) Miscellaneous:

The contact details for a doctor, a treating veterinarian and a farrier will be given to the Competitors upon arrival. The cost for these services is at the Competitors own expense.

ANNEX 1

JUNIOR WORLD TROPHY 2008

RULES

(approved by ICKD - Geneva, 27.01.2008)

I GENERAL

Art. 1 - Competitors

Invitations to compete are sent to National Federations and to representatives of ICKD or organisations who care for kids driving in their countries. Eligible to compete are young Competitors from the age of 7 to 18 years who are qualified according to the criteria defined by their national organisation, provided that their turnout meets the requirements defined for their Class.

The Competition is held for Single Ponies in six Classes, graded according to the age of the Competitors and in one Class for Pony Pairs:

*) Stickmeasure of Ponies in classes 2 & 3 is rounded to next lower 5 centimeters (examples: 130=130,132=130).

In all Classes grooms must be 18 years of age or above (year of birth 1990 or earlier). Parents may be grooms.

Ponies must be 5 years of age or over.

Each invited Nation is allowed to enter up to 8 Competitors for the Single Pony Competitions. To be part of the Team Competition, a Nation must have at least 3 Competitors in three different Single Pony Classes.

For the Pony Pairs Class up to two Competitors per Nation may be entered.

Art. 2 – Competitions

The Event is held as a Combined Driving Competition, consisting of three single Competitions:

- Competition A: Driven Dressage**
- Competition B: Obstacle-Cone Driving with fixed Obstacles*)**
- Competition C: Obstacle-Cone Driving Fault Competition**

*) No fixed obstacles for Class 1

Classification for Individuals and Teams for Single Ponies, for Individuals in Pairs Class.

Presentation will be a separate Competition with individual classification. The result does not count to the Combined Results for Individuals and Teams. Participation in this Competition is compulsory.

Art. 3 – Carriage & Harness

Competitors are allowed to use carriages with 2 or 4 wheels. Bridles with blinkers and - if a carriage has no brakes - breeching is compulsory, otherwise the Competitor is not allowed to compete.

The track width of the carriage is free. Carriages with pneumatic tyres are allowed.

The same carriage has to be used in Competitions A, B and C.

In case of a damaged carriage no more usable the competitor can be allowed by the Jury to use another carriage of the same type.

Art. 4 – Passport and Proof of Vaccination for Ponies

A valid FEI Passport, National Passport or National ID-card with a vaccination certificate is to be shown for each Pony.

The vaccinations of the Ponies must be in accordance with the ÖTO (6-month interval).

Art. 5 - Restrictions

One Pony may be used by two Competitors, provided that the official order of starting and timetable are not affected.

A Competitor has to compete with the same pony in Competitions A, B, C and Presentation and is not allowed to compete more than once in any Competition.

Grooms may ride on a carriage with as many Competitors as necessary, a Competitor (born 1990) may ride once with another Competitor if required, provided that the official order of starting and timetable are not affected.

Art. 6 - Insurance

The Competitor has to give evidence of a thirdparty liability insurance by producing a copy of the insurance policy. For persons under the age of 18 parents or legal guardians have to declare in writing the acceptance of liability.

Art. 7- Jury

The Jury consists at least of three judges. One of them must be a foreign FEI Judge with qualification I or O.

Art. 8 – Order of Starting

The order of starting for each Class in Competition A will be determined by a Draw at the Chefs d'Equipe meeting on Wednesday 23rd July.

The Competitors in the second half of Competition A will start first in Competition B followed by the Competitors in the first half of Competition A. In case of an uneven number of Competitors the groups will be divided in such a manner that there will be one more Competitor in the first group to start in Competition A.

Examples:

Even: Starting order Competition A 1-2-3-4 becomes Starting order Competition B 3-4-1-2

Uneven: Starting order Competition A 1-2-3-4-5 becomes Starting order Competition B 3-4-1-2-3

The Order of Starting per Class in Competition C is the reverse order of the Combined Classification after Competitions A and B. Competitors who Retired or were Eliminated in Competitions A or B will start first in each class.

Art. 9 – Qualification Check

Before the start of Competition A (Driven Dressage) the qualification of Competitors and Ponies will be checked as follows:

- Veterinary inspection of Ponies:
 - Identification from Passport or ID Card.
 - Age check.
 - Height check (see Art. 1).
 - Vaccination check.
 - Overall check of ability to compete.
- Inspection of Competitor, carriage and harness
 - Personal qualification of competitor and groom
 - Safety of carriage and harness
 - Measuring of the track width (rounded to 5 cm, i.e.. 90=90, 92-->95)

II Competitions

Art. 10 – Competition A – Driven Dressage; Presentation

The scheduled Driven Dressage Test must be driven from memory.

A Safety hat is compulsory, a back protector is recommended for Competitor and groom in Competition Driven Dressage as well as in Competition Presentation.

The Driven Dressage test is assessed separately by three judges positioned at C, B and E. Faults in Competition A will be penalised by judge at C according to ÖTO Rules (Annex 3).

The score will be calculated to two decimal places as follows:

Maximum points of test - (Total points of all judges / 3) + Penalties judge C = **Score Competition A**

Art. 11 – Competition B – Obstacle-Cone Driving with fixed Obstacles

A Safety hat and back protector are compulsory for Competitor and groom. The fixed obstacles are constructed on flat ground. A maximum of three obstacles may be multiples.

Cantering is only allowed in the fixed obstacles and a maximum of 4 strides after the finish line of a fixed obstacle, any further strides will be penalised (First incident 5 points, second incident 10 points, third incident elimination).

The time elapsed in a fixed obstacle as well as the time for the entire course is measured to two decimal places.

Dislodgeable Elements and other faults will be penalised according to ÖTO Rules (Annex 3).

If a competitor damages an obstacle the competitor has to stop immediately after the bell is rung by the jury. The groom has to stand by the head of the pony until the obstacle is rebuilt.

The Competitor may only restart after the President of Jury advises him to do so. Multiple and fixed obstacles have to be re-driven from the beginning.

The time within a fixed obstacle will be penalised with 0,2 points per second, calculated to two decimal places.

Exceeding the time allowed for the entire course will be penalised with 0,5 points per second, calculated to two decimal places.

To exceed the maximum time (double the time allowed) for the course entails elimination.

In Class 1 the groom is allowed to give help by voice and gestures.

After the start of Competition B the Jury may - after consultation with Technical Delegate and Course Designer - change the time allowed after three competitors. The results of the first three competitors will be adjusted accordingly.

All faults during this competition not mentioned in these rules separately will be penalised by the Jury according to ÖTO Rules (Annex 3).

The total of all penalties gives the result of Competition B.

Art. 12 – Competition C – Obstacle-Cone Driving Fault Competition

A Safety hat is compulsory, a back protector is recommended for Competitor and groom. Up to three obstacles may be multiples.

Cantering is not allowed and will be penalised after more than 4 strides (First incident 5 points, second incident 10 points, third incident elimination)

The time for the entire course from start to finish is Calculated to 2 Decimal places.

Dislodgeable Elements and other faults will be penalised according to ÖTO Rules.

If a competitor damages an obstacle the competitor has to stop immediately after the bell is rung by the jury. The groom has to stand by the head of the pony until the obstacle is rebuilt.

The Competitor may only re-start after being advised by the President of Jury to do so. Multiple Obstacles have to be re-driven from the beginning.

Exceeding the time allowed for the entire course will be penalised with 0,5 points per second, calculated to two decimal places.

If the maximum time is exceeded (twice the time allowed) for the course, this will entail elimination.

In Class 1 the groom is allowed to give help by voice and gestures if necessary.

After the start of Competition C the Jury - after consultation with Technical Delegate and Course Designer - may change the time allowed when three competitors have finished the course. The results of the first three competitors will be adjusted accordingly.

All faults during this competition not mentioned in these rules separately will be penalised by the Jury according to ÖTO Rules (Annex 3).

The total of all penalties gives the result of Competition C.

III Classification

Art. 13 – Individual Classification

The result of each Competition is shown by listing the Competitors in increasing order of their scores.

The total result of the Combined Competition will be determined by adding the Scores of Competition A, B and C per Competitor. The Competitor with the lowest total number of penalties is the winner. In the case of an equality of scores on completion of the three Competitions, the Competitor with the least number of penalties in Competition B will be classified above the others. If there is still an equality of points, the scores in Competition A will be the deciding factor. If there is still an equality competitors will be equally placed.

Competitors who did not compete at or did not finish one of the Competitions will not be placed, but shown at the end of the result list.

Art. 14 – Team Classification

An official Team Classification will only be published for the Combined Event.

For the Team classification a Competitor placed first in his class is awarded with 20 points, second with 19 points and so on, down to place 20 with 1 point. Equal places are awarded with same number of points. (Example: Place 1, 2, 2, 4 gives 20, 19, 19, 17 points)

The Team Score is determined by adding the awarded points for the best three places in three different Classes per Team within one Competition.

Adding the Team Score of Competition A, B and C for one Team gives the Combined Team Score. The Team with the highest Combined Team Score is first.

Scores of Team members who do not have a score in one of the three competitions are not considered in the Team Classification.

All members of placed Teams are invited to the Prize-giving ceremony.

Art. 15 – Prize-giving

Prize-giving for Individual Classification will take place for Competitions A, B, C and the Combined Competition as well as for the Competition Presentation

Prize-giving for the Team Classification will only take place for the Combined Competition.

One third of the Competitors and Teams will be placed at each prize-giving ceremony.

For the Combined Competition the first three Individuals and Teams receive medals, all placed competitors receive prizes in kind.

The winning Team is awarded with the JUNIOR WORLD TROPHY for the next two years.

V Important Basic Rules

Art. 16 – Behaviour at the event site

- Competitors own cones are not allowed in the training and practise areas. The OC will supply 4 pairs of cones at the training arena.
- Competitors must be properly dressed in the Competition Areas.
- A Competitor may not be accompanied by more than 2 persons in the Competition Area.
- Salutes at the start and finish of Competitions A, B and C are compulsory.
- The final practice area must not be used more than 30 minutes before the scheduled time of Competition.
- In case of a carriage with 4 wheels the groom has to be seated inactive in the back of the carriage except in the fixed obstacles in Competition B.

Art. 17 – Reasons for Elimination

If a competitor cannot start at one of the three Competitions he is allowed to start the next Competition but will not be considered in the Combined Classification.

The Jury can eliminate a competitor before or during a competition due to

- the bad physical condition of a pony
- an injured pony
- an obviously dangerous pony
- the bad condition of a carriage and/or harness
- a broken carriage or harness

In any of these cases a Competitor is not allowed to compete any further.

Additional Reasons for Elimination

- Cruelty to a Pony by a Competitor, groom or coach.
- Incorrect dress in the Competition areas.
- A Competitor does not conform to the timetable.
- Outside assistance.
- Incorrect conduct at the Practice Arena
- Entering the Arena without permission.
- A Competitor does not start within 60 seconds of the bell being rung (to be decided by President of Jury)
- Leaving the Arena whilst still in Competition.
- Intervention or assistance of a groom during the competition (exception Class 1)
- Turnover of a carriage.
- Error of course not corrected
- Missing the start line or finish line.

Art.18 – Objections

Each problem concerning the interpretation of these rules or obviously missing rules has to be dealt with by the Jury and a decision to be made if necessary based on the appropriate ÖTO Regulations.

The decision of the Jury is final. There is No Appeal.
